MINUTES

A. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Ronald G. Harris, Jr. called the meeting to order at 6:31 p.m.

- 1. Discuss, consider and take action on an Ordinance adopting the 2019-2020 Budget and appropriating resources for the budget year beginning October 1, 2019.**

Mayor Pro Tem Harrison made a motion to approve an ordinance adopting the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Annual Budget and appropriating resources for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019 and ending September 30, 2020 as proposed with a second by Councilmember Rivers.

2. Discuss, consider and take action on an Ordinance levying and adopting the tax rate at a rate of \$0.647489 per one hundred dollars (\$100.00) assessed valuation on all taxable property within the corporate limits of the City for the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year.

Councilmember Rivers made a motion that the total property tax revenues be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.647489 per \$100 assessed valuation, which is effectively an 11.55% increase in total property tax revenue with a second by Mayor Pro Tem Harrison.

The motion carried unanimously.


E. EXECUTIVE SESSION – None
