

A Mayoral Declaration of Local State of Disaster due to Public Health Emergency was signed by Mayor Harris on March 20, 2020 as a result of the COVID-19 Virus pandemic. The declaration is only valid for seven (7) days without consent of the City Council. The attached Resolution must be approved by the members of the Council for the declaration to be valid for longer than seven (7) days.

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-03-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KRUM, TEXAS RATIFYING A DISASTER DECLARATION DUE TO THE COVID-19 VIRUS AND CONSENTING TO CONTINUATION FOR MORE THAN SEVEN DAYS.

WHEREAS, the City of Krum is a Type A General Law Municipality located in Denton County, Texas, created in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas and the Constitution of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020, Mayor Ron Harris, acting in accordance with authority granted to him under Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code, declared a local state of disaster for the City of Krum due to the COVID-19 virus (the “Disaster Declaration”); and

WHEREAS, Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that such a declaration of disaster may not be continued for a period of more than seven (7) days except with the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision: and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020, the Governor of Texas issued further guidance in Executive Order NO. GA-08; and

WHEREAS, such Executive Order states that every person should avoid all social gatherings in groups of more than ten (10) people; and

WHEREAS, the City Council supports the disaster declaration signed by Mayor Ron Harris on March 20, 2020, and consents to its continuation for a period of more than seven (7) days with an amendment consistent with the Governor’s Executive Order indicated herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KRUM, TEXAS:

Section 1: The Council hereby ratifies the Disaster Declaration signed by Mayor Ron Harris on March 20, 2020, and consents to its continuation for a period of more than seven days, and amends such declaration to state that every person should avoid all social gatherings in groups of more than ten (10) people and, **OTHER PROVISIONS AS APPLICABLE** such Disaster Declaration is hereby continued until such time as it is terminated by order of the Council.

Section 2: This Resolution shall be in full force and shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

**CITY OF KRUM, TEXAS
MAYORAL DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF
DISASTER DUE TO PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, beginning in December 2019, a novel coronavirus, now designated COVID- 19, has spread through the world and has now been declared a global pandemic by the World Health Organization; and

WHEREAS, symptoms of COVID-19 include fever, coughing, and shortness of breath and, in some cases, the virus has caused death; and

WHEREAS, prudence dictates that extraordinary measures must be taken to contain COVID-19 and prevent its spread throughout the City of Krum, including the quarantine of individuals, groups of individuals and occupied structures and, additionally, including compelling individuals, groups of individuals, or occupied structures to undergo additional health measures that prevent or control the spread of the virus; and

WHEREAS, Governor Abbott and Denton County have declared a local disaster due to public health emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DECLARED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF KRUM, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That a local state of disaster due to public health emergency is hereby declared for the City of Krum, Texas, pursuant to section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster due to public health emergency shall continue for a period of not more than seven (7) days from the effective date of this Declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of Krum, Texas.

SECTION 3. Pursuant to section 418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster due to public health emergency shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

SECTION 4. Pursuant to section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this Declaration of a local state of disaster activates the City of Krum's Emergency Management Plan.

SECTION 5. That this Declaration hereby recommends the postponement or cancellation of all events or gatherings where 10 or more persons are in a confined space.


SECTION 6. That this Declaration hereby authorizes the use of all lawfully available tools to enforce this Declaration, including but not limited to, the penalties set forth in section 418.173 of the Texas Government Code.

SECTION 7. That this Declaration shall take effect beginning March 20, 2020.
