

NOTICE OF ELECTION

TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SAID CITY:

TAKE NOTICE that an election will be held in said City as provided in a RESOLUTION BY THE TEMPORARY BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PROPOSED KRUM CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT, CALLING AN ELECTION (the "Resolution") and an ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KRUM, TEXAS, CALLING AN ELECTION (the "Ordinance"), each of which were duly passed by the Temporary Board of the Proposed Krum Crime Control and Prevention District and the City Council of the City, respectively, on February 1, 2016.

The Resolution and the Ordinance each provide substantially as follows:

RESOLUTION BY THE TEMPORARY BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PROPOSED KRUM CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT / ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KRUM, TEXAS, CALLING AN ELECTION TO BE HELD WITHIN THE CITY ON THE PROPOSITION OF APPROVING THE CREATION OF THE KRUM CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT, THE ADOPTION OF A LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX AND THE REDUCTION OF A LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX; MAKING PROVISION FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE ELECTION; AND CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS INCIDENTAL THERETO

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Krum, Texas (the "City") approved Ordinance No. 2015-12-01 on December 7, 2015, proposing the creation of the Krum Crime Control and Prevention District (the "District") and the imposition of a local sales and use tax by the District (the "District Tax") and appointing a temporary board of directors for the District (the "Temporary Board") in accordance with Chapter 363, Texas Local Government Code (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Act, the Temporary Board met on January 18, 2016 and adopted a two-year crime control plan and a two-year budget plan, each of which is available for inspection at the office of the City Secretary; and

WHEREAS, following a successful election on the proposition on May 11, 2013, the City adopted a "Type A" local sales and use tax (the "Type A Tax") for the promotion and development of new and expanded business enterprises at the rate of ½% pursuant to Chapters 501 and 504,

Texas Local Government Code and Chapter 321 of the Texas Tax Code (collectively, the “Tax Act”); and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the City Council and the Temporary Board that, upon the approval of the proposition contained herein, the District Tax be adopted at a rate of ¼% and the Type A Tax be reduced by ¼% from a rate of ½% to ¼%; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirements of the Act and the Tax Act, if the creation of the District, the imposition of the District Tax and the contemporaneous reduction in the Type A Tax as described herein are approved by a majority of the qualified voters of the City at the election called herein, the combined rate of all local sales and use taxes, including the tax approved pursuant to the election called hereby, imposed by the City and other political subdivisions having territory in the City will not exceed two percent; and

WHEREAS, this Temporary Board / City Council deems it advisable to call the election hereinafter ordered; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that holding the hereinafter called election on the date set forth below is in the public interest; and that the meeting was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place and purpose of the meeting was given, all as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.

BE IT ORDERED BY THE TEMPORARY BOARD OF THE DISTRICT / CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF KRUM, TEXAS:

1. An election shall be held between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. on May 7, 2016 in the City at the following designated polling place:

Krum ISD Central Administration Building
1200 Bobcat Boulevard
Krum, Texas

The City shall constitute a single election precinct for the election, and all resident, qualified electors of the City shall be entitled to vote at the election.

2. The appointment of the Presiding Election Judge and Alternate Presiding Judge for the designated polling place shall be made by Lannie Noble, the Denton County Elections Administrator (the “Elections Administrator”), in accordance with the agreement between Denton County (the “County”) and the City for the County to conduct the election as a joint election with other entities in Denton County (the “Elections Service Agreement”). By passing this Resolution / Ordinance the Temporary Board / City Council approves and concurs in the appointment of the aforesaid election officers. The Presiding Judge shall appoint not less than two qualified election clerks to serve and assist in conducting the election; provided that if a Presiding Judge actually serves as expected, the Alternate Presiding Judge shall be one of such clerks.

3. Early voting by personal appearance shall be available at all locations established by the Elections Administrator pursuant to the Elections Service Agreement. The Elections Administrator shall serve as the early voting clerk in accordance with the terms of the Election Services Agreement. During the period early voting is required or permitted by law, being April

25, 2016 through May 3, 2016, the hours designated for early voting by personal appearance shall be from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. on each day except on May 2, 2016 and May 3, 2016 when the hours for early voting will be from 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M., and no early voting will be conducted at any early voting location on Sundays and legal state holidays. The early voting clerk shall keep the early voting places open during such hours for early voting by personal appearance. All voters may vote at any early voting location. The main early voting polling location for the election and an early voting location in the City shall be as follows:

In addition to the foregoing early voting locations, early voting shall be conducted for all voters by personal appearance at the designated early voting polling places administered by the Elections Administrator, as set forth in Exhibit A hereto.

4. Applications for early voting by mail shall be delivered to the Elections Administrator, no later than the close of business on April 26, 2016, at the following address:

If application to vote by mail is made by personal delivery, the application must be delivered by the close of business on April 22, 2016.

5. As early voting clerk, the Elections Administrator shall receive applications for early voting ballots to be voted by mail. An early voting ballot board ("EVBB") and signature verification committee shall be created to process early voting results from the election. The County shall appoint the EVBB in accordance with the Election Services Agreement to process early voting results from the election. The presiding judge of the EVBB, with the assistance of the Elections Administrator, shall appoint two or more additional members to constitute the EVBB. The Elections Administrator shall determine the number of EVBB members required to efficiently process the early voting ballots.

6. All resident, qualified electors of the City shall be entitled to vote at the election.

7. Notice of the election shall be given by posting a substantial copy of this election Resolution / Ordinance on the bulletin board used for posting notices of the meetings of the City Council, not less than 21 days prior to the date set for the election; and a substantial copy of this election Resolution / Ordinance also shall be published on the same day in each of two successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City, the date of the first publication to be not later than the 35th day prior to the date set for the election and the date of the second publication to be not earlier than the 30th day or later than the 10th day prior to the date set for the election.

8. At the election the following PROPOSITION shall be submitted in accordance with law:

PROPOSITION

The creation of the Krum Crime Control and Prevention District dedicated to crime reduction programs and the adoption of a proposed local sales and use tax at a rate of $\frac{1}{4}\%$, and the reduction of the local sales and use tax currently levied for the promotion and development of new and expanded business enterprises in the City from a rate of $\frac{1}{2}\%$ to $\frac{1}{4}\%$.

9. The official ballots for the election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code so as to permit the electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid PROPOSITION.

10. In all respects the election shall be conducted in accordance with the Texas Election Code. Pursuant to the federal Help America Vote Act and the Texas Election Code, each polling place shall be provided at least one voting system equipped for individuals with disabilities. Sufficient voting equipment to accommodate the voters shall be provided for early voting and at the polling place on election day.

11. This Resolution / Ordinance shall be effective immediately from and after its passage.
